

- Line Spacing: 1.5 inch for text. Single spacing may be used only in the Table of Contents, footnotes and endnotes, charts, graphs, tables, quotations, appendices, and references.

Page Margins:

• Left side: 1.5 inch, Right side: 1 inch, Bottom: 1 inch, and Top 1 inch (But chapter page should have 2 inches at the top)

• 12 for main text, and 16 for chapter title, and 14 for heading of the chapter (like 1.1 Background)

Page Number:
