General Guidelines for Format

Paper:

- Use A4 size white paper and print only on single side of the paper

Paragraph and line space

- Line Spacing: 1.5 inch for text. Single spacing may be used only in the Table of Contents, footnotes and endnotes, charts, graphs, tables, quotations, appendices, and references.
- Alignment: Justified

Page Margins:

- Left side: 1.5 inch, Right side: 1 inch, Bottom: 1 inch, and Top 1 inch (But chapter page should have 2 inches at the top)

Font:

- Time New Roman

Font size:

- 12 for main text, and 16 for chapter title, and 14 for heading of the chapter (like 1.1 Background)

Page Number:

Beginning with the first page of the **main body of the text**, pages are numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3, 4, etc.) in the **top right** of the each pages. **All pages preceding** the first page of the body are counted and numbered with lower case Roman numerals (ii, iii, iv, etc.) must be in the **bottom centre**. The title page is counted but the number is not printed on the page.

Citation and References:

- APA (American Psychological Association) method and in alphabetical order with hanging indent.
